PRESS RELEASE

On the evening of October 30th, and 31st, 2017, Sheriff Capers of the San Jacinto County Sheriff's Office, along with the Texas Department of Public Safety Criminal Investigation Division and the Texas Attorney General's Office Fugitive Apprehension Unit, conducted sex offender compliance checks.

Personnel were divided up into teams and given assignments of locations where sex offenders registered in San Jacinto County resided. Personnel travelled throughout San Jacinto County visiting residences of the sex offenders and ensuring that they were in compliance with Texas Criminal Code of Procedures.

During this operation of compliance checks, personnel travelled to 117 offender locations. Out of those 117 locations, contact was made with 65 offenders and 52 offenders were not contacted due to being at work or another viable reason.

A total of 7 offenders were found to be not in compliance and are being investigated for their infractions at this time with possible criminal charges pending, depending on how their individual cases were structured at the time of their pleadings.

Sheriff Capers initiated this task force with multiple agencies to ensure that our citizens and their children were safe within our community.
